

## **CAMPUS VISIT PROTOCOLS**

## Please review the following guidelines in detail. Questions should be directed to the Webb Admission Team at <u>admission@webb.org</u>.

- 1. Campus tour are by appointment only.
- 2. Campus tours for prospective students are limited to students and parents/guardians only.
- 3. Campus tours may take place while enrolled students and staff are present. Visitors are not permitted to interact with any on-campus student activities.
- 4. All social distancing strategies are to be observed at all times, including proper physical distancing, face masks worn by parties at all times, temperature checks at check-in and other infection control measures as applicable.
- 5. Visitors arriving at Webb with non-enrolled children must ensure that these children stay next to an adult, avoid touching any other person or any item that does not belong to them, and are masked if 2 or older and not at risk due to a respiratory condition.
- 6. Movement of visitors on school grounds is limited to designated areas, such as the reception or lobby area, offices, conference or meeting rooms and public rest rooms to the extent feasible.
- 7. Visitors must wear a face mask at all times while on Webb's campus. This applies to adults and to children 2 years of age and older. Masks with one-way valves must not be used. To support the safety of visitors and Webb community members, face masks will be made available to visitors who arrive without them.\*

\*Individuals who have been instructed by their medical provider that they should not wear a face mask must wear a face shield with a drape on the bottom edge, to be in compliance with state directives, as long as their condition permits it.

- 8. Visitors must complete a mandatory health survey that will be sent to them via email the morning of their visit. The health survey must be completed and submitted by noon Pacific Time. Survey responses will be reviewed by a member of the Webb Admission Team, who will contact the party if it becomes necessary to re-schedule the tour.
- 9. Visitors will be asked to submit to temperature checks while checking in for their campus tour.
